

The RUNIC ALPHABET

Runes are the earliest letters of the Teutonic Alphabet used especially by the Scandinavians and Anglo-Saxons. They date from as early as the 2nd Century AD. The letters are thought by some to be of mystical or magical significance.

The practical view is that they were formed by modifying Roman or Greek characters to enable ease of carving on wood or stone.
